



The South Milwaukee Police Department, along with Project Child Safe, is pleased to offer free gunlocks to citizens of South Milwaukee.

Project ChildSafe is a nationwide program whose purpose is to promote safe firearms handling and storage practices among all firearms owners through the distribution of key safety education messages and free gun locking devices (firearms safety kits). The program is supported by a U.S. Department of Justice grant (DOJ), the National Shooting Sports Foundation (NSSF), and is a component of Project Safe Neighborhoods.

Come into the South Milwaukee Police Department and pick up your free gun locks today! Locks will be given out on a first come, first served basis. The South Milwaukee Police Department is open 24 hours a day, however, after 8:00p.m. during weekdays, and during all weekend hours, distribution will be based upon Officer availability at the Police Department.

REMEMBER:

No firearm's safety or lock can be a substitute for safe, careful gun handling and storage. This lock is intended to discourage unauthorized access to a firearm, particularly by young children. This lock may be cut or defeated by a determined individual and may not prevent intentional misuse of a firearm.
